PERFORMANCE DAY INFORMATION:

- The Theatre Showcase will take place on Tuesday, June 1st at Hendricks Hall on the UCM Campus.
 - Hendricks Hall is in the Administration Building near the corner of Maguire & South Street.
 - Limited parking is available in the Visitor's Lot- additional parking can be found across the street from the visitor's lot.
- Students will need to arrive at Hendricks Hall, dressed and ready to perform by 7:00pm.
- Students should enter the theatre to rehearse.
- Parents/guests are asked to wait in the lobby until the house opens at 7:30pm.
- Admission is free & there is no limit on the number of guests who can attend!!



MASKS & SOCIAL DISTANCING:

After careful consideration, we have decided to follow the updated UCM mask policy for our audience members during the Theatre Showcase, making masks optional for fully vaccinated individuals and strongly recommended for all others.

- We are still requiring social distancing when seated in the audience.
- Considering the close proximity and nature of activity, all theatre students & CS Staff will continue to wear masks as planned, including during the performance.

PERFORMERS:

- Theatre 1-4 classes, Jr. Players, CS Players and Private Theatre Students
- When students are not performing, they will be seated in the audience to watch the show!

COSTUMING:

- CS Theatre shirts will be provided for all performers! (Shirts are coming home with students this week!)
- Students should wear jeans or black bottoms that they can move in comfortably!
- Closed toed shoes- again that they can move in comfortably.
- Accessories: fun socks, small jewelry, headbands, scarf, etc... (NO HATS please!)
- A mask they can speak well in, make sure they don't sound muffled in the mask (disposable works best). Preferably no words on the mask.
