Backstage Volunteers!

- Thank you to everyone who has already volunteered to help backstage!
- As a volunteer, you WILL be able to stand in the BACK of the audience to watch your child during the performance during which you are helping backstage & will NOT need a ticket to that show.
- AGAIN, THIS YEAR! A background check will be run on ALL backstage volunteers prior to approval. NO
 ONE WHO HAS NOT HAD A BACKGROUND CHECK RUN IN ADVANCE WILL BE ALLOWED BACKSTAGE.
- If you have not already done so, please stop by the front desk to fill out a form providing us with your Name, Date of Birth, SSN and Address that states that you give CSA permission to run a background check with your information.
- Due to limited Dressing Room space, only a limited number of parent volunteers will be permitted to remain backstage! If you have not already signed up to help backstage and you would like to do so, please check the sign-up form online and if your class is already full, send us a text to see if there is still space!

Show Week Rehearsals! MONDAY, NOVEMBER 27- FRIDAY, DECEMBER 1

- The week leading up to the show will have special rehearsal times for all performers that take the place of your regular ballet class (see schedules below). Mon. & Tues. will be In-Studio Rehearsals, Wed. & Thurs. will be Staging Rehearsals and Friday will be the DRESS REHEARSAL for the GOLD CAST.
- THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE CANCELLED NOV. 27-30: All Ballet, Pointe, Leaps & Turns and Kindergarten Combo classes, Tap Tech 2/3, 4, 5a & 5b, Jazz Tech 5, Lyrical 5, Pre-Company 3 Tap, Teen Tap 2, Hip Hop 5 & Stretch class.

Please Note: Attending Nutcracker rehearsals takes priority over your regularly scheduled classes, so if you are one of the few dancers with a conflict, be sure to attend your Nutcracker rehearsal time!

STAGING REHEARSALS: GOLD CAST: Wed. & Thurs, Nov. 29-30, Hendricks Hall- UCM Campus

During these rehearsals, dancers will NOT attend their REGULARLY SCHEDULED ballet classes. Instead, all dancers should report to **HENDRICKS HALL** at his/her scheduled rehearsal time. **THE PARTY SCENE WILL NOT REHEARSE ON WED. OR THURS. BUT WILL HAVE THEIR STAGING AND DRESS REHEARSALS BOTH ON FRIDAY!**

• What To Wear: Wear your ballet class attire (leotard, tights, ballet shoes and hair in a bun)! Costumes will not be worn. Show make-up & hair is not required.

- When To Arrive: Be in the auditorium ready to dance at your appointed time as each class has a very limited amount of time. Dancers only need to come for their specific rehearsal time & should leave after rehearsing.
- Where To Enter: Please enter through the front/main doors of Hendricks Hall and head directly into the auditorium to wait.
- What Should Parents Do: Parents can drop their students off and return at the end of their child's rehearsal time, or watch quietly in the audience.
 - o DO I NEED TO CHECK IN MY STUDENT? No-there is no student check in for Staging Rehearsals.

DRESS REHEARSAL: GOLD CAST DETAILS: Fri. Dec. 1 at Hendricks Hall- UCM Campus

Dress rehearsal is MANDATORY. We enforce this strict policy for the confidence and safety of the performers. It is crucial that every student rehearse on the stage before performing and know exactly where he or she needs to be at all times.

- What To Wear: Dress rehearsal is a time for all students to rehearse all of their numbers in all pieces of their costumes & practice their hair & make-up to prepare for the performance!
 - o **Have your make-up & hair done!** Read the class info sheet on how your class is expected to style your hair/make-up and arrive at dress rehearsal with your hair and make-up already done!
 - Dancers should arrive already wearing tights (without underwear), and optional body liner UNDER your clothes.
 - We also ask everyone to bring/ wear simple pants and a button or zip front top/ jacket to wear when you are not in costume backstage.
- When To Arrive: Please arrive at your appointed call time and remember to bring your ballet shoes! PLEASE DON'T BE LATE. We will do our best to begin and end as promptly as possible. However, this takes cooperation from everyone.

DANCER DROP OFF! To make checking dancers in more convenient and faster for parents & more secure overall, we will have a **drive through drop off/ check-in** for all dancers!

- To help with traffic flow, please drive through the UCM Visitor parking lot off of South Street & Maguire at the staggered call times to drop off your dancer! CSA Staff will direct you!
 - o If you would like to accompany your dancer to their dressing room, you can do so! Plan to park and walk your dancer in at the arrival time!
- Check-In Process: ALL DANCERS MUST CHECK IN so we know you have arrived!

What Should Parents Do:

- Parents of dancers in **6th grade & up** can drop their dancers off and pick them up at the end of their rehearsal (see estimated times below). These dancers can check themselves in and out!
- Parents of dancers in K-5th grade need to check their student in & out. Parents will give CS Staff a
 secret word at drop off. You will then need to tell CS Staff the word to check your child out!

The MANDATORY Dress Rehearsal will proceed in the following order: GOLD CAST & PARTY KIDS ONLY!

All dancers should leave rehearsal after your last number is finished rehearsing. No Curtain Call rehearsal.			

NO FOOD is allowed backstage during the dress rehearsal or performances! There are too many white costumes to take ANY chances! (Water bottles with caps are permitted.)

AFTER CHECKING IN!

- **DANCERS!!!** Report to your assigned room and check in verbally with staff/volunteers. Make sure you use this room as your dressing room; do not switch to another room to be with your friends.
 - o This is where our staff will find you throughout the rehearsal.
- Your costume will be labeled & waiting for you in or near your dressing room. Staff/ Volunteers will give you further instructions on when to change into them. Please be patient during this process!
- Please remember that you are RENTING these costumes from Center Stage and treat them with care! A damaged costume fee will apply if careless behavior causes harm to your child's costume. Thank you!
- **PARENTS!!!** If you choose to accompany your child in, please then leave your dancer at the dressing room with staff & volunteers until they have finished rehearsing.

AFTER REHEARSING!

- **IMPORTANT!** After you are done rehearsing your last number you will need to turn all pieces of your costume back in with staff/volunteers! You should then check out with CS staff & leave the rehearsal.
- PARENTS! All K-5th grade students must be checked out by a guardian! For rehearsal this will happen outside their dressing rooms. 6th & up students can check themselves out. Parents- If you are watching the dress rehearsal, please come check your child out after they finish and then you can continue watching the rehearsal with your child.

- What To Wear: Dancers should arrive already wearing tights (without underwear) & optional body liner UNDER your clothes with your make-up & hair done.
- We also ask everyone to bring/ wear simple pants and a button or zip front top/ jacket to wear when you are not in costume backstage. If dancers choose to go to the balcony to watch they show, they will need to have clothes on over their body-liner/leotard.
- When To Arrive: Please arrive at your call time by class & remember your ballet shoes!

DANCER DROP OFF/CHECK-IN!

- To help with traffic flow, please drive through the UCM Visitor parking lot off of South Street & Maguire at the staggered call times to drop off your dancer! CSA Staff will direct you!
 - o If you would like to accompany your dancer to their dressing room, you can do so! Plan to park and walk your dancer in at the time below!
- Check-In: ALL DANCERS MUST CHECK IN so we know you have arrived!

What Should Parents Do:

- Parents of dancers in **6th grade & up** can drop their dancers off. These dancers can check themselves in and out!
- Parents of dancers in K-5th grade need to check their student in & out. Parents will give CS Staff a
 secret word at drop off. You will then need to tell CS Staff the word to check your child out!
- The box office opens 1 hour before the show & the audience will open 30 minutes before show time!

AFTER CHECKING IN!

- **DANCERS!** If you are in **Act I**, please follow instructions on changing into your costume and then remain in your dressing rooms, calmly to protect your costumes, until you are asked to line up!
- If you are in **Act II**, wait to change into your costume until instructed to do so & remain calmly in your dressing room until Center Stage Staff or a Volunteer gives you further instructions.

WHILE BACKSTAGE:

- All students will stay backstage for the entire performance. Depending on the number of seats available in the balcony, students may or may not be able to go out and watch the show as a class. Dancers might want to bring along a few quiet, CLEAN activities.
- The only drinks allowed backstage are bottles of water with caps. ABSOLUTELY NO FOOD IS ALLOWED BACKSTAGE! We have too many white costumes in this performance to take any risks with even "clean" snacks backstage. Please have your dancers eat a good meal before the performance to tide them over.

Curtain Call!

- All students will be in the curtain call! For the safety of all performers backstage, parents will not be allowed to check out their child prior to the conclusion of the curtain call.
- After the curtain call, ALL students will return to their assigned dressing areas.
 - IMPORTANT! Dancers MUST turn all pieces of their costume back in with staff/volunteers before you leave after each performance!
 - Due to limited time in between shows, dancers will not be able to take pictures on stage after any
 of the performances.
 - CS Staff & Volunteers will try to take pictures of students backstage in costume!
 - PARENTS! To maintain an organized, safe and secure environment for all children, we are asking for
 only one person to pick up their dancer after the show. You will need to sign them out in the lower
 Hendricks lobby and NOT in the dressing rooms.
 - o There is no rush to get to the sign-out area! Wait and hang out a bit before packing into the lower lobby. :) All of the dancers have to change out of their costumes and gather their personal items, before they will be escorted as a group to the check-out area! It will take at least 10 minutes before any dancers are ready to be checked out!

General Information:

- SHOW ORDER sheets are available online & at the front desk if you would like one.
- Tights are available to purchase at the front desk & will be available backstage at the performances. We can charge your account so no cash or card is necessary!
- VIDEOS & PICTURES: You are welcome to take pictures (no flash) and video of the performance. HOWEVER, please be courteous of audience members behind you. NO tripods or standing up in the audience to video.
- Please remember to be a courteous audience member. Enter and exit the house only through the back doors between numbers.
- **No guests should ever meet a dancer backstage!** Our space is extremely limited, and for the safety of our performers, we do not allow any additional people backstage. Parent Volunteers and staff will make sure all students are accounted for and help out when needed.
- **Dads, brothers, etc.:** Please be aware that dancers often have to make quick changes directly backstage or offstage. We make every effort to provide a modest changing area, but this is impossible at certain times. Please make a conscious effort to avoid all areas around the stage.

REMINDER! Names must be clearly placed in all personal belongings, especially your ballet shoes! Be sure to leave all valuables at home! Center Stage is not responsible for lost/damaged phones, tablets, etc...
